

What to Bring to Mountain Pine Dermatology, PLLC

Adult New Medicare Patients

If you have a Medicare Insurance policy, at your first visit you will be asked for:

- Driver's License or Government Issued ID
- Insurance Card(s)

To expedite the registration process, you can print out the appropriate patient forms, complete at home or your office and bring to your first visit.

Registration Forms are on the **Patient Info** website tab under the **Medicare Insured** icon.

Adult New Patients

If you are **over 18** or older and are a new patient and **do not have any Medicare Insurance Policy**, at your first visit you will be asked for:

- Driver's License or Government Issued ID
- Insurance Card(s)

To expedite the registration process, you can print out the appropriate patient forms, complete at home or your office and bring to your first visit.

Registration Forms are on the **Patient Info** website tab under the **ALL OTHER PATIENTS** icon.

Pediatric New Patient

If the patient is under 18 years of age (minor), the parent or legal guardian must accompany the minor to the first visit as well as any visit in which any invasive treatment is provided.

Legal guardians must provide proof of guardianship. NO EXCEPTIONS

To expedite the registration process, you can print out the appropriate patient forms, complete at home or your office and bring to your first visit.

Registration Forms are on the **Patient Info** website tab under the **MINOR PATIENTS** icon.

Established Patients

If you are an established patient, the Customer Service Representative will verify:

- Address
- Identity by a picture ID – Driver's License or Government Issued ID
- Proof of Insurance – Current Insurance Card(s)
